

What is Carpet Shampoo?

CARPET SHAMPOO is a concentrated cleaner which lathers up to a rich, stable foam that removes and suspends soil from carpet fibres. It produces a dry foam that will not wet the carpet backing.

How Does It Work?

CARPET SHAMPOO is a concentrate that is diluted with water. The solution is applied to the carpet via a rotary scrubbing machine with a nylon brush. A rich foam is massaged throughout the fibres.

As the carpet dries, the shampoo and soilage dry to a crystalline, non-oily residue that can be removed by vacuuming. CARPET SHAMPOO contains anti-resoiling resins that protect the carpet fibres and keep carpets looking cleaner longer.

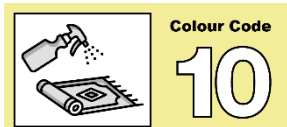

Colour Coding



Product identification is made easy with the Agar Colour Coding system. We have 11 different categories of product that are identified by colour and number. The product itself has this colour. Also, the colour and number are shown:

1. On the bottle label as supplied.
2. On the matching Dispenser Spray Bottle.
3. On the product chart for Colour Coded Cleaning

Application

- Get some help to lift furniture off the carpet and place it out of the way. Leave heavy objects in place. Put aluminium foil under the legs of furniture to prevent stains from water contact.
- Erect a 'Cleaning in Progress' sign.
- Dry vacuum the carpet to remove loose dust and dirt.
- Dilute to 1 in 10-20 with water depending on the degree of soiling of the carpet.
- Apply the solution and machine the carpet, with a nylon brush and work the foam into the pile uniformly across the floor.
- Allow to dry then vacuum to remove soil and shampoo residues,
OR
 Wet vacuum to remove the soil and shampoo using clean water in the solution tank. Do not over-wet the carpet.

Disposal Information

1. Used solutions -

Used Solutions of CARPET SHAMPOO should be poured into a drain or trough that leads to the sewer system or a septic tank. These systems have a method for treating and breaking down the waste. Used solutions of detergent should not be poured into stormwater drains or down driveways as these drains are designed for rainwater and ultimately lead to the local river system.

2. Unused product

It is best to keep the product and use it up! If this is not possible, try to give it to someone who can use it. (Make sure the product is in its original, labelled container).
If there is no alternative but disposal, it is safe to pour modest quantities of this product down the drain (to sewer) with running water. Leave the cold tap running for a few moments afterwards as this dilutes the product and reduces the concentration in the wastewater.

Remember, do not mix different cleaning products together during disposal!

3. Empty packaging

Bottles and drums

Our 5L and 20L bottles and drums are made from HDPE (polyethylene) or PET which can be recycled. You can dispose of these containers via the kerbside collection program or other recycling system. CARPET SHAMPOO containers will be cleaned and reused if returned to Agar Cleaning Systems Pty Ltd, significantly reducing plastic usage and waste.

Cardboard cartons

Used boxes should be flattened and recycled in OCC (old, corrugated cardboard) or mixed wastepaper recycling programs.
